

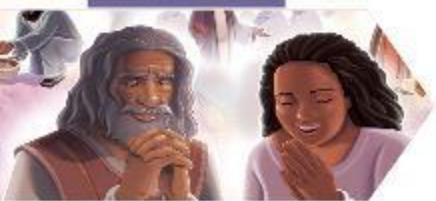

Question 1:

How did today's story teach us that Jesus loves everyone?
How can we love others who are different from us?

Answer:

Question 2:

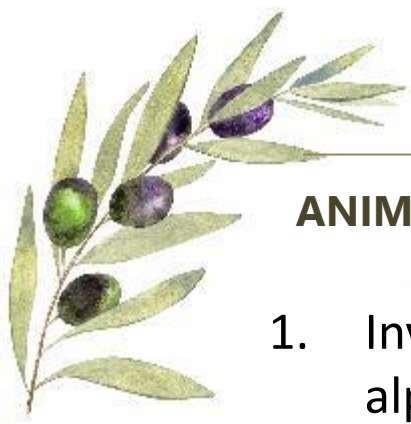

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Game 1:

ANIMAL SOUNDS

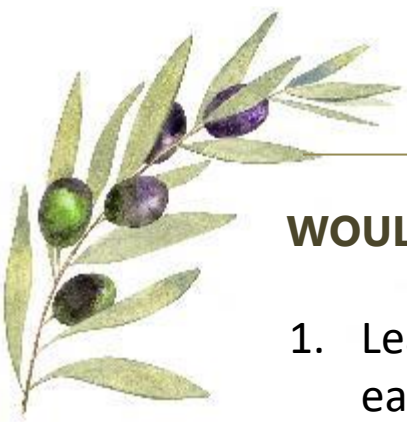
1. Invite kids to sit in a circle. Lead kids to go through the letters of the alphabet by making an animal sound that starts with that letter.
 1. For example, for the letter “A” a kid could simulate the sound of an alligator by clapping their hands together.
 2. Or for the letter “B,” a kid could growl like a bear.
2. Invite the other kids to guess the animal for each sound. Be sure to offer help to kids stuck on a letter.
3. Consider skipping the letters X and Y.



Game 1:

BIBLE CONNECTION

Those were some fantastic animal sounds! God has made so many amazing animals. Long ago, God said that some animals were unclean for His people to eat. In our story today, we heard how God told Peter that all animals were made clean. Through this, God was teaching Peter that He loves all people, Jews or Gentile. Jesus makes all things clean.



Game 2:

WOULD YOU RATHER

1. Lead kids to form a circle. Ask kids a would you rather question about what to eat such as “Would you rather eat a peanut butter and pickle sandwich or broccoli pizza?”
2. Allow kids to choose a response and defend their answer. Consider using the following options or create your own:
 1. yogurt with fish or onion ice cream
 2. pea soup or a shrimp flavored soda
 3. asparagus cookie or garlic pudding
 4. carrot donut or mushroom bread



Game 2:

BIBLE CONNECTION

None of these options seem very appealing, do they? Today, we learned that when Peter was given a vision of different unclean animals to eat, none of them were appealing to Peter either.

In the Old Testament, the Law commanded God's people to not eat certain foods to show they were set apart from other nations. But now that Jesus died for everyone's sins, God was teaching Peter that everyone can be saved, not just the Jews.
