

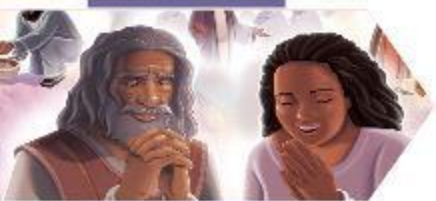

Question 1:

The church prayed for Peter. Why do we pray?

Like Peter and the praying church, we can trust that whether God chooses to rescue us or not, Jesus has saved us to enjoy heaven with Him.

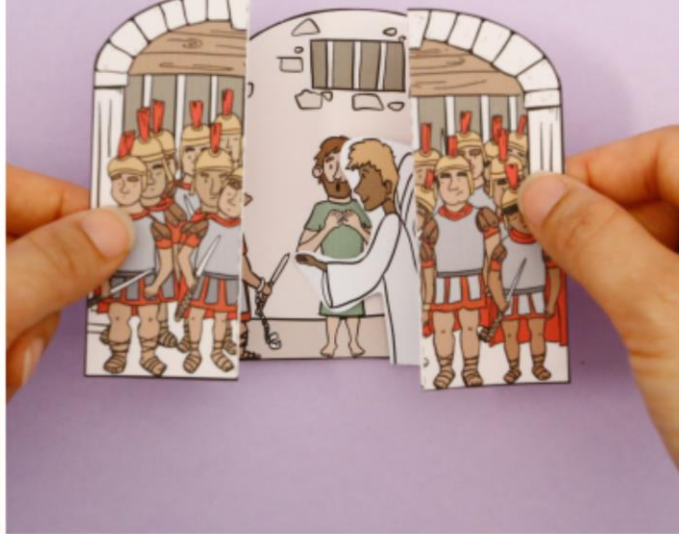


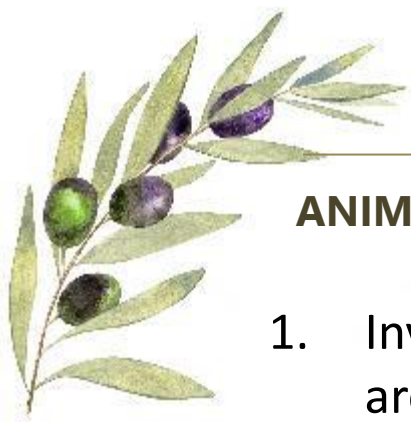
Craft/Game Time

Game 1:

ANIMAL SOUNDS

1. Invite kids to line up behind you. Tell kids that they are to follow you around the room, copying the movements you make.
2. Lead kids by hopping, skipping, walking backwards, and so on.
3. After 30 seconds or so, choose a kid to be the leader. Direct him to lead the kids using different movements. Continue switching leaders as time allows.
4. For an added challenge, consider turning off the lights at various times. Tell kids that when the lights are off, they must freeze. Then turn the lights back on and resume the activity.



Game 1:

BIBLE CONNECTION

Today, we learned how Peter was put in prison and it looked like he would be killed for his faith in Jesus. Yet, God listened to the praying church and chose to send an angel to lead Peter out of the prison. The angel told Peter to get up and follow him.

Nothing is too hard for God. Not even the metal chains, 16 soldiers guarding Peter, and the prison gates!



Game 2:

RESCUE CHARADES

1. Form kids into groups of three or four.
2. Explain to each group that they have one to two minutes to act out a rescue scene. As the groups act out the scene, the other kids will guess what rescue attempt they are portraying.
3. Assign groups a rescue scene such as a lifeguard rescues kids in the ocean, a fireman rescues kittens from a burning building, a ranger rescues a family lost in the woods, a ski patrol rescues people from an avalanche, etc.



Game 2:

BIBLE CONNECTION

Seeing someone rescued from a dangerous situation causes us to celebrate and be thankful. Today, we learned how God rescued Peter from prison and how the church was praying for Peter's rescue.

Prayer makes a difference in what happens, and the Bible teaches us that as we pray, we must have faith that God hears and will act. While God does not answer every prayer as we may like, we can trust that He hears and is working through our prayers to help us trust Him more.
