# Youth Group Mokjang Sharing

Sunday Passage: Acts 10:9-33, Questions:

## **FAMILY CHALLENGE:**

- **God might not show you what to do in a vision like He did for Peter and Cornelius. And though much of His will and plan is laid out for us in the Bible, we don't read specific instructions for our lives there. Allow each person to share a situation in which he or she would like to know God's will.**
  
- **Discuss how God's Word could guide that decision, then pray over that person, asking God to help him or her know how to act. Consider writing down what each person shares so you can look back and see how God showed you the way.**
