How did the Holy Spirit show His power through the disciples?

Game 1:

BLOWN AWAY

- 1. Provide each kid with a balloon and instruct them to write their name on their balloon using a marker to help keep up with which balloon belongs to them.
- Lead kids to blow up their balloons as much as possible or use an air pump to blow up the balloons for the kids. Then direct kids to line up on one side of the room and release their balloons to see how far they fly.
- 3. Ask kids to share how their balloons were able to move across the room. Prompt kids to discuss the sound the balloons made as the air was released.
- 4. Repeat the activity and consider allowing kids to have a contest to see whose balloon travels the farthest.

Game 1:

BIBLE CONNECTION

Your balloons had 'power' to fly around the room because they were filled with air. When the air was released, it was like a rushing wind that moved the balloons. We even heard the sound the air made as it was released.

Today, we learned how the Holy Spirit came to the disciples like a loud rushing wind and gave them power to speak in other languages.



CAN YOU NAME IT?

- 1. Use an electronic device with internet capabilities to play recordings of someone saying "hello" in four or five different languages.
- 2. Form kids into groups of three or four. Challenge kids to work together as a group to decide what language is being said.
- 3. Invite kids to practice repeating the language aloud.
- 4. If a group guesses the correct language, they earn one point. Repeat with the other languages. The team with the most points at the end, wins.

Game 2:

BIBLE CONNECTION

Can anyone here speak more than one/two language? [Allow responses.]

It's a wonderful gift to speak different languages. Now, has anyone here been able to speak a language they have never been taught? [Allow responses.]

Learning a new language usually requires years of study! In today's story, we learned how the Holy Spirit empowered the disciples to share the gospel in languages they had never learned before.
